TREK NEW ZEALAND: Abel Tasman

11th – 22nd October

CHARITY CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION ***(only 30 places available)**

- Be over 18 under 75 and available on the Trek dates of 11th ~ 22nd October 2011
- This Trek is graded, challenging, but with no altitude considerations
- Be in good health, capable of moderate walking for six full days up to 6-8 hours/day
- Have a full 10 year Passport valid until at least six months after return
- To reserve a place with a deposit of £500 payable to 'The Fire Fighters Charity'
- Placements initially on Trek dealt strictly on a 'first come *(with deposit) first served' basis
- Registration Form completed and returned with deposit to Sports & Overseas Fundraiser FFC
- Medical Declaration to be completed and returned *in confidence to Discover Adventure
- Obtain current certificates for various Vaccinations, including tetanus and recommend that you have protection against Polio and Typhoid. Refer to your GP/Travel clinic for most up to date information
- Own adequate insurance for the Trek, or obtain DA policy, currently @ £64.27 *more if extending
- Insurance application, or proof of own Insurance Policy, must be returned direct to DA
- No Visas are required for New Zealand
- After deposit commence £3,000 of fundraising, or sponsorship for the Fire Fighters Charity
- On acceptance, a 'Fundraising Pack', including a FFC Bank paying-in book will be provided
- Prior to final confirmation of a place, *to have deposited 80% funds by 11th August 2011
- To have banked whole of fundraising by time of travel to New Zealand on 11th October 2011
- Exceptionally any difference to the total sum, may be accepted in the form of a post dated cheque
- Provide own spending money, tips \$30, 2 meals, Airport Tax *currently NZ \$25 & *Fuel Surcharge if applied
- Opportunity/help with joint fundraising and National initiatives/Draws/events, credits
- Opportunity to walk/meet fellow participants being arranged Lake District mid Jan 11
- Opportunity to meet the Trek Staff Team will be arranged at end of May 2011 venue TBC
- In the event of withdrawing from Trek, participants will forfeit at least their deposit
- If withdrawing *any reason within last two months varying tour cost element is payable
- Earliest notice of problems to be given, as the Charity will still be charged for place
- If withdrawing Monies collected, still to be deposited with Charity *(may credit to future Trek/Challenges)
- Early Bird incentive *DA *Trekking Kit Bag* for those achieving £3,000 target by July 2011
- Fundraising minimum Targets refer to monies banked and therefore exclude Gift Aid and deposit
- Fundraising totals however exceeding £5,000 *including Gift Aid attracts a £400 part/deposit refund
- Participant's Flights from London Heathrow (terminal 3) and arrive 3 hours earlier
- Bookings for optional activities in Kaikoura and East Coast to be booked direct with Discover Adventure
