About Ouseburn Farm

Ouseburn Farm is a working city farm in Newcastle. The charity helps adults with learning difficulties, provides local children with access to a green space and teaches them about the origins of food. £400 from the profits of this event will be donated to Ouseburn Farm.

Hotel Waldeck is a favourite destination, where we've enjoyed Brigitte's hospitality on many occasions. With the meandering Mosel river at the bottom of the road and a beautiful woodland backdrop, this is the perfect place to relax in the bar and enjoy lovely home-cooked food.

Valkenburg – enroute we'll visit the magical Christmas markets of Valkenburg in the Netherlands, where you will find an array of gifts. The Municipal Cave is the largest, oldest and most visited underground Christmas market in Europe and The Velvet Cave has impressive mural paintings, sculptures and a unique 18th century chapel.

Bonn – this former capital of Germany is a vibrant university city and home to Beethoven. The old town hosts the Christmas market, selling everything from chestnuts to bees wax candles.

Rudesheim – has become a favourite destination for many of our regular travellers. With the bustle of the markets in the old quarter, käthe Wohlfahrt's famous Christmas Shop, the quaint Drosselgasse and the cable car ride, there will be something for everyone in this lovely touristy town



Bernkastel-Kues – this is truly the chocolate-box village of this visit! With its quaint little houses and cobbled streets, this is a must to get you in the Christmas spirit. You'll find the largest Advent calendar in the Mosel region in the market square, as well as some lovely market stalls. The architecture here is stunning too, look out for the flood markers on the buildings, dating back over 200 years!

Trier – is Germany's oldest town, with UNESCO status, dating to 16 BC. It is famous for its huge Roman wall, the Porta Nigra. There are around 100 stalls nestled around St. Peter's cathedral (the oldest in Germany) and the town square. A truly magical atmosphere with a stunning backdrop.

Koblenz – situated in the old town, the market has over 130 stalls and includes a Christmas bakery, where you can watch stollen, biscuits and other Christmas delicacies being made. You can stroll along to the confluence of two world-famous rivers, the Rhine and Mosel. Try the food in The Old Brewery pub, such as brewing stew & dumplings!

Andernach – is another ancient Roman town, boasting some beautiful architecture, including the famous Alt Krah (old crane). From roasting almonds to fresh bread, the sights and aromas of Andernach's small market will tempt you to enjoy the stalls selling crafts, wooden toys and delicious food.

Cochem Castle – There is also an opportunity for us to enjoy a tour of the castle followed by a medieval banquet in the Knights Hall (optional excursion).
